

# 10 Network Security Devices

- 4. Unified Threat Management (UTM) Systems** UTM devices combine multiple security functions—firewall, IPS, antivirus, web filtering, and VPN—into a single appliance, ideal for small to medium businesses with limited resources.
- 5. Network Access Control (NAC)** NAC enforces security policies by allowing only authorized devices, users, and applications to access the network. It ensures endpoint compliance and supports zero-trust architectures.
- 6. Web Application Firewalls (WAF)** WAFs protect web applications by filtering HTTP/S traffic, blocking attacks like SQL injection and cross-site scripting. They are essential for customer-facing apps and APIs.
- 7. VPN Gateways** VPN gateways encrypt remote-access traffic, creating secure tunnels for distributed teams. They ensure confidentiality and integrity of data transmitted over public networks.
- 8. Routers with Security Features** Modern routers not only direct traffic but also include access control lists and basic firewall capabilities, helping secure data routing between networks.
- 9. Network Load Balancers (NLB)** NLBs distribute network traffic efficiently across multiple servers, maintaining low latency and high availability while preventing overloads that could be exploited by attacker...
