Uzbekistan is actively expanding its fiber optic network domestically and internationally, including the strategic Trans-Caspian cable linking it to Azerbaijan and regional deployments across multiple provinces. Domestic Fiber Optic Expansion Domestically, Uzbekistan has been modernizing its telecommunications infrastructure, which historically relied on Soviet-era systems. The country has deployed fiber optic backbone lines totaling over 1,500 km as of 2012, with ongoing projects significantly expanding coverage. Key regional projects include:

- Andijan, Namangan, and Fergana regions:** Installation of 438 km of fiber optic cables, including Optical Ground Wire (OPGW), Underground Fiber Optic Cable (UGFOC), and Optical Fiber Approach Cable (OFAC), as part of the World Bank-supported Electricity Sector Transformation and Resilient Transmission (ESTART) Project.
- Bukhara and Khorezm regions:** Deployment of 273 km of fiber optic cables under the same ESTART initiative, aimed at modernizing the electricity and telecommunications infrastructure.

These projects are managed by the JSC National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan and executed by local companies such as JSC ELEKTRQIS...
