

Adding a fiber optic connector

Step 5: Secure and Cure Depending on the connector type, either cure the epoxy using a UV lamp or thermal oven, or mechanically secure the fiber in the connector. Ensure the fiber is stable and the ferrule is properly seated.

Step 6: Polish the Fiber End Polish the fiber end using appropriate polishing pads to achieve a smooth, flat surface. Proper polishing reduces signal loss and ensures optimal contact with mating connectors.

Step 7: Inspect and Test Examine the fiber end under a microscope for cracks, chips, or scratches. Perform a flex test to check for fiber integrity. Finally, test the connection using an optical power meter or OTDR to verify signal strength and insertion loss.
