- Link Aggregation:** Supports protocols like LACP to combine multiple physical links into one logical connection, increasing bandwidth and providing redundancy.
- Routing and Switching:** Operates at Layer 2 or Layer 3, performing switching based on MAC addresses and sometimes routing based on IP addresses.
- Quality of Service (QoS):** Prioritizes critical traffic such as voice or video to maintain service quality.
- Security:** Implements access control lists (ACLs) and other policies to block unauthorized traffic and protect the network.
- Redundancy and Reliability:** Often includes power redundancy and failover capabilities to maintain network operation during failures.

Importance in Network Architecture

In a three-tier network design—access, aggregation, and core—the aggregation switch acts like a "project manager," filtering, balancing, and forwarding traffic from the access layer to the core layer. This hierarchical approach improves scalability, reduces broadcast traffic, and simplifies network management compared to a flat network design. Without aggregation switches, each access switch would need a direct connection to the cor...
