Chassis ID Behavior In a virtual chassis (VC) or stacked switch environment, each member switch must have a unique chassis ID. If two switches in the same VC share the same chassis ID, the system will generate errors, and network instability can occur, such as MAC flapping or temporary MAC table flushes. This is because the VC uses the chassis ID to identify and manage each member, and duplicate IDs prevent proper topology recognition and forwarding. VLAN and Network IDs VLAN IDs, while logically significant within a LAN segment, are locally significant to a switch or VRF. This means the same VLAN ID can exist on different switches or VRFs without conflict, as long as they are not globally reused on the same switch or interface. However, some platforms, like Palo Alto firewalls, restrict the same VLAN ID from being assigned to multiple subinterfaces under a single physical interface, requiring separate physical interfaces for multiple virtual systems. Practical Implications Adding a new switch to a VC: Always assign a unique chassis ID to avoid conflicts and MAC flapping. VLAN reuse: VLAN IDs can be reused across different VRFs or switches, but within a single switch or VC, each VLAN ID must be unique to avoid configuration errors. MAC table behavior: When a new member joins a VC, MAC addresses may temporarily appear to flap due to FDB resynchronization, especially if the new member has a shorter uptime than the master switch. Summary IDs from the same network connection in the same chassis are not automatically the same. Chassis IDs must be unique within a VC, and VLAN IDs have local significance but cannot be duplicated on the same switch or interface.
