Hot-Swappable and Redundant Design Many core switches allow hot-swapping of boards, meaning modules can be replaced or upgraded without shutting down the switch. This is critical for mission-critical networks where downtime can cause significant disruption. Redundancy is often built into both the supervisor and power modules, and some switches support dual supervisor modules for failover, enhancing reliability.

Performance Considerations The number and type of boards directly affect the switch's forwarding rate, backplane bandwidth, and latency. High-capacity line cards with large buffers enable the switch to handle bursty traffic from multiple distribution switches without packet loss. Supervisor modules with advanced ASICs ensure wire-speed routing and switching across all ports.
