

Bus connector torque



Overview

Correct torque creates metal-to-metal contact pressure while avoiding thread damage. For copper busbar joints (indoor switchgear, clean dry conditions): For aluminum busbar joints: Reduce torque by 15-20% compared to copper (softer metal, creeps under load) Correct torque ensures stable clamping force, minimizes contact resistance, and prevents overheating over long-term operation in electrical enclosures. Why are manufacturer torque values higher than general standards?

Manufacturers base torque values on long-term testing and safety margins. A properly torqued joint with clean contact surfaces carries rated current at 30-40°C above ambient. Hot busbar joints don't announce. * Bronze alloy bolts shall have a minimum tensile strength of 70,000 pounds per square inch. ** Bolts, cap screws, nuts, flat washers, locknuts: 18-8 alloy. NOTE: An impact wrench is not to be used during any torqueing operation. Clearances are maintained and encroachment by or adjustments are performed. from other equipment facilities has not occurred. Designers, installers, and users know that for high-current busbars handling hundreds and thousands of amps, it's details such as contact resistance.
