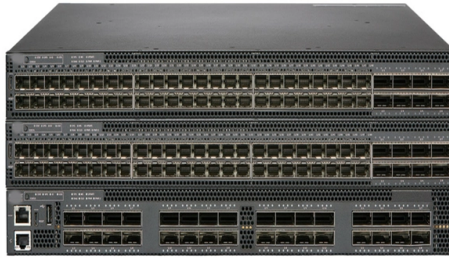

Cable Type and Insulation For construction site distribution boxes, rubber-insulated cables are recommended for both incoming and outgoing lines due to their flexibility, durability, and resistance to mechanical stress and environmental factors such as moisture and dust. Cable Entry and Protection Cables should enter the distribution box through lower-end ports equipped with protective rings to prevent abrasion and mechanical damage. All cable inlets and cover joints must be well-sealed to prevent dust, water, or debris from entering the box. Proper cable management inside the box, including neat routing and secure connections, is essential for safety and heat dissipation.

Grounding and Safety The metal body of the distribution box, internal metal plates, and electrical appliances must be reliably grounded. The protective neutral wire should be connected through a terminal board, and all connections must comply with local electrical codes and standards such as NEC, IEC, or AS/NZS 3012 for construction sites. Leakage protectors and circuit breakers should be installed according to manufacturer instructions and test...
