Overview of Primary and Secondary Distribution

Primary distribution systems carry high-voltage power from substations to distribution transformers, while secondary distribution delivers low-voltage electricity to end-users or construction site loads (). The cable connecting the primary to secondary box typically transitions from high-voltage feeders to low-voltage circuits at a pad-mounted transformer or secondary distribution enclosure ().

Cable and Conduit Requirements

Conduit Type: Use HDPE SDR 13.5 for open trenches and SDR 11 for boring installations (). Conduits should be color-coded (orange with red stripes) for primary circuits.

Elbows: Install 90-degree, 24-inch radius Schedule 80 PVC elbows at risers into secondary boxes or pull boxes ().

Trenching: Maintain proper depth and separation from other utilities. Typically, a minimum of 3 feet clearance from above-ground equipment is required ().

Pull Boxes: Install pull boxes or handholes at intervals to facilitate cable pulling and future maintenance. The size of secondary boxes is designated by the engineer ().

Installation Practices

Coordination: Prior to construction, coordinate with the utility company for easements, route approval, and inspection requirements ().

Routing: Follow the project sketch provided by the utility, ensuring the conduit route avoids obstacles and complies with local codes ().

Safety: Adhere to all applicable building and safety codes, including grounding, bonding, and protective devices for laterals...
