Ensuring Low-Resistance Grounding The total grounding resistance should be less than 0.1 ohm between system parts to ensure effective fault current dissipation. For longer cables or multiple spindles, additional parallel grounding wires may be required to maintain low resistance. Avoid relying on sequential connections; use parallel grounding paths to prevent a single point of failure. Safety and Maintenance Ensure all connections are tight, corrosion-free, and clearly labeled for inspection. Test grounding resistance after installation and periodically, especially in varying soil conditions, to maintain effectiveness. Use high-quality materials, such as copper-bonded steel rods, to prevent corrosion and maintain long-term reliability.
