

Cable tray CT installation



AI Overview

Cable tray installation involves careful planning, material inspection, proper support placement, alignment, and adherence to safety and electrical standards.

Planning and Preparation Before installation, review approved shop drawings to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations, ensuring coordination with other services and compliance with project specifications. Inspect all materials, including trays, ladders, bends, tees, reducers, covers, and supports, for damage, coating integrity, and compliance with approved submittals. Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports to prevent warping or moisture damage.

Selecting Tray Type and Sizing Choose the appropriate tray type based on load, airflow, and cable type:

- Ladder trays: allow ventilation and easy cable entry
- Perforated trays: support lighter loads
- Solid-bottom trays: protect cables from dust or debris

Calculate tray width and depth according to cable count, type, and spacing requirements to prevent overheating and ensure efficient use of space.

Support and Mounting Install supports using GI threaded rods (10mm for trays below 300mm, 12mm for above 300mm) and slotted GI channels fixed with nuts and washers. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load. Ensure vertical and horizontal alignment using spirit or laser levels. Provide adequate clearance for cable installation and maintenance.

Installation Procedure Mark the route from panels to designated areas as per shop drawings. Install supports and channels securely to ceiling, walls, or floor. Assemble trays with bends, tees, and other accessories to form complete runs before laying cables. Secure trays using manufacturer-approved hardware, ensuring no sagging or stress on cables. Maintain segregation for power, data, and control cables, applying color coding if required. Bond trays to the main earthing system using copper wire or equivalent conductors to ensure electrical continuity.
