An IP Rating is represented by the letters “IP” followed by two digits. The first digit (0-6). The IP code or Ingress Protection code indicates how well a device is protected against water and dust. It is defined by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) under the international standard IEC 60529 which classifies and provides a guideline to the degree of protection provided.
