

Cable tray cabling procedures

Proper cable tray cabling involves planning the route, selecting the right tray type, sizing, securing supports, installing cables with correct spacing, and adhering to safety and NEC standards.

Planning and Preparation Before installation, review approved shop drawings to determine tray routes, lengths, and locations, ensuring horizontal and vertical runs avoid clashes with other services and allow future maintenance access. Inspect all materials for compliance with specifications and damage, storing trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports to prevent deformation or moisture exposure.

Tray Selection and Sizing Choose the appropriate tray type based on cable type and environment:

- Ladder trays:** Ideal for heavy power cables, allow airflow, and easy cable entry.
- Perforated trays:** Suitable for lighter loads and ventilation.
- Solid-bottom trays:** Protect sensitive instrumentation or control cables from dust and electromagnetic interference.

Tray width and depth must accommodate the number and type of cables while maintaining proper spacing to prevent overheating and ensure compliance with fill capacity limits.

Mounting and Supports Secure trays using brackets, clamps, and hangers at intervals typically ranging from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. Ensure trays are level, straight, and properly aligned, using rollers for long runs to prevent kinks or damage during cable installation.

Cable Installation Maintain minimum bend radius for cables at tray entry and exit points. Separate power, control, and communication cables to reduce electromagnetic interference. Use cable ties or clamps to keep cables organized without over-tightening, which could damage insulation. Ensure grounding and bonding for metallic trays to comply with NEC Article 392 and enhance safety.

Compliance and Safety Only tray-rated cables should be installed, capable of withstanding heat, moisture, and mechanical stress. Adhere to NEC standards for tray fill, voltage separation, and firestop measures. Verify that all materials, tools, and in...
