FireMaster® Cable Tray Wraps: These are insulated wraps for instrument control cables, providing 30-minute hydrocarbon fire protection. The wrap consists of FireMaster® Marine Plus blanket fully encapsulated in aluminum foil, secured with steel banding straps at 150 mm centers. Overlaps of 50-75 mm are used at joints, and additional weather protection can be added with corrugated aluminum sheeting. The system is FM Approved and tested according to ASTM E1725-95 and ASTM E1529 hydrocarbon fire curves.

Prysmian FP400 and FP600 / Draka Firetuf: These cables are compatible with fireproof tray systems like Cablofil, providing enhanced fire resistance for both low and high voltage applications.
