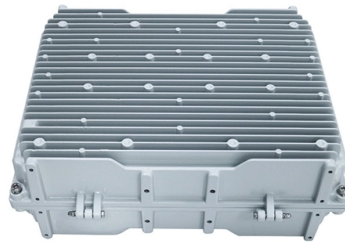

They can be configured in ladder, channel, or perforated styles and are often combined with accessories like corbels, hangers, and fixations to support the weight over extended distances. Large-span trays are suitable for indoor and outdoor industrial environments, including areas with harsh weather or corrosive conditions. Perforated and Solid Trays While perforated trays provide continuous cable support with ventilation holes, they are generally used for moderate spans or mixed cable systems. Solid-bottom trays are less common for long spans due to their weight and limited ventilation but are used when protection from dust, moisture, or electromagnetic interference is required.
