Standards and Compliance Cable tray tees should comply with NEMA VE standards and local electrical codes, ensuring safe and reliable cable management. Proper selection of material (aluminum, steel, or stainless steel) and finish is important for corrosion resistance and mechanical strength, depending on the installation environment.
