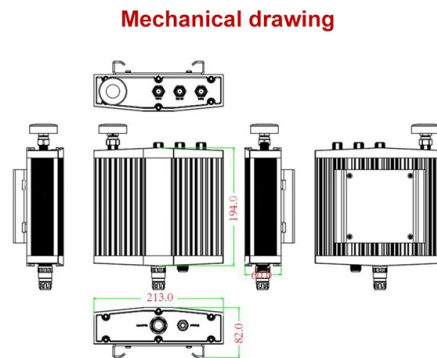

Steel RTQ tees may have dimensions like 60x200mm, 60x500mm, or 60x600mm, with galvanized finishes according to DIN EN 10346.
