

Can a router bridge a mobile fiber optic cable

This setup avoids double NAT issues and allows full control over your network. Connecting Your Router to Fiber Install the ONT/ONU: Connect the fiber cable from your ISP to the ONT/ONU's optical port. Link to Router: Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT/ONU's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Configure VLANs if Required: Some ISPs require specific VLAN IDs for fiber connections. Ensure your router is configured accordingly to maintain internet access. Power and Test: Power on the ONT/ONU first, then the router. Verify that the router receives the internet signal and that Wi-Fi or wired connections function properly.
