- Buffer/Coating:** Protects the fiber from physical damage and environmental factors .

Some fiber optic cables include metallic elements like steel or aluminum for strength, support, or grounding, but these metals do not carry the optical signal—they only provide mechanical reinforcement .

Comparison with Metal Cables

Metal cables, such as copper or aluminum, transmit electrical signals, not light. While they are cost-effective and durable, they are susceptible to electromagnetic interference and have lower bandwidth compared to optical fibers . Optical fibers, in contrast, offer higher data rates, immunity to EMI, and longer transmission distances, which is why glass or plastic is essential for their function .
