

Check the router's MAC address on the core switch

`Copy show ip arp | include` This will display the MAC address associated with the router's IP.

Step 4: Trace the MAC Address in the Switch Once you have the MAC address, check which port it is connected to using the MAC address table:
`Copy show mac address-table address` This command shows the VLAN and the physical port on the switch where the router is connected. If the MAC address points to an uplink port, continue tracing through downstream switches until you reach the router's access port.

Step 5: Verify the Router's MAC Address For Cisco devices, you can also confirm the router's MAC address directly on the router using:
`Copy show version` or by checking the interface status:
`Copy show running-config` The base Ethernet MAC address is typically listed under the VLAN1 interface or the router's main interface.

Additional Tips Keep MAC address tables updated and periodically check for unauthorized devices. If using a TP-Link router, you can also find the MAC address via the web interface under the Status page or on the device label. Use `show cdp neighbors` to trace connections between switches if multiple layers exist in the network. By following these steps, you can accurately id...
