Ribbon fibers also follow the same 12-color pattern for each 12-fiber ribbon layer. Jacket Color Coding In addition to individual fiber colors, the outer jacket of the cable often indicates the fiber type: Yellow: Single-mode fiber (OS1/OS2) Orange: Multimode fiber (OM1/OM2) Aqua: Laser-optimized multimode fiber (OM3/OM4/OM5) This allows technicians to quickly identify the fiber type without opening the cable. Summary By following the TIA-598-C standard, the 12-core optical cable ensures error-free fiber identification, simplifies splicing and termination, and maintains consistency across installations. Remember that for higher-count cables, the same 12-color sequence is applied repeatedly within tubes or ribbons, and the outer jacket color provides additional information about fiber type.
