Kitchen Appliances	20–32A MCB	Dedicated circuits for oven, microwave, dishwasher, refrigerator
Air Conditioning / HVAC	20–32A MCB	Each unit typically requires a separate breaker
Water Heater / Electric Shower	30–40A MCB	High-power appliances need dedicated protection
Outdoor / Garden Circuits	16–20A MCB	Includes lighting, pumps, or EV chargers; may require RCD protection
RCD / RCBO	30–63A, 30mA sensitivity	Protects against earth faults; often covers multiple circuits
Surge Protection Device (SPD)	As per rating	Protects sensitive electronics from voltage spikes
Spare Slots	20–30% of total ways	Recommended for future expansion like EV chargers or solar panels

Key Points

Ways/Slots: A “way” is a slot for one MCB or RCBO. For example, a 12-way box may have 10 circuits plus main switch and surge protection.

Main Switch Rating: Must accommodate the total expected load. Modern homes often use 100A–200A main switches.

Safety Devices: RCDs or RCBOs are essential for protection against electric shock, especially in wet areas like bathr...
