IEC Reference Designations

The IEC 61346-2 and IEC 81346-2 standards provide a structured approach:

- Function aspect:** Represents the electrical function (e.g., =N for a 400 V supply).
- Product aspect:** Represents the type of device (e.g., Q for circuit breakers, T for transformers, A for assemblies/switchboards).

Full designation example: A circuit breaker in panel A1 fed from supply N1 could be labeled as =N1-A1-Q1. This method is hierarchical and flexible, allowing for expansion and clear identification of complex systems.

NEC and Practical Labeling

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC, Article 408.4): Each circuit must be legibly marked to indicate its purpose or use. Labels should specify the room, outlet, appliance, or fixture the circuit controls. Use durable labels or digital label makers for clarity and longevity. For example, a label might read: "Kitchen Outlets – P1-A3-Q5", combining location, panel, and circuit number.
