- Bus Bars:** Conductive bars distribute electricity from the incoming line to multiple outgoing circuits. They are typically made of copper or aluminum and are insulated to prevent accidental contact.
- Neutral Link:** Provides a return path for current, ensuring proper circuit operation and system stability.
- Grounding Bus Bar:** Offers a safe path for excess current to flow into the ground during faults, preventing electric shocks and fire hazards.
- Surge Protective Device (SPD):** Protects the system from voltage spikes caused by lightning or switching surges, safeguarding sensitive equipment.
- Indication Lights:** Visual indicators show the status of mains power supply and circuit operation, helping in monitoring and maintenance.
