

Configuration of a 4-way Fiber Optic Switch

Step 4: Configure Ports for Fiber Enable the fiber-optic ports on each switch and configure the speed and duplex mode according to your network requirements. For switches supporting ring topology (e.g., Siemens Scalance X204-2), ensure the ring ports are correctly assigned to allow automatic failover and redundancy.

Step 5: VLAN Configuration Create VLANs to segment network traffic. Assign the fiber ports to the appropriate VLANs to ensure proper data flow between switches. For industrial switches, you may need to configure Style 7 (Class X) or Style 4 (Class B) wiring depending on your network topology.

Step 6: Network Topology Considerations Decide on a star or daisy chain topology. Star topology centralizes traffic through a main switch, while daisy chain...
