Power Isolation: Before wiring, turn off the circuit breaker supplying the switch box and verify with a non-contact voltage tester to ensure safety.

Dual Switch Setup: You can either use a duplex switch (two switches in one device) or a double-gang box with two single-pole switches side by side. Both methods allow independent control of two electrical loads from a single location.

Wiring Method: Bring the incoming hot wire into the switch box, split it to feed both switches, and connect each switch to its respective load (e.g., light fixture and fan). Ensure neutral and ground wires are properly connected according to local electrical codes.
