

Connecting an optical switch to a regular switch

Step 5: Configure the Switches Once physically connected, configure the regular switch to recognize the optical link. This may involve enabling the SFP port, setting the correct speed (e.g., 1 Gbps or 10 Gbps), and verifying link status. On the optical switch, select the input source if it supports multiple devices.

Step 6: Test the Connection Verify connectivity by checking link lights on both switches.
