

Connection of Level 3 Distribution Box

Install Circuit Breakers Position the circuit breakers in the designated slots. Connect each outgoing circuit wire to its corresponding breaker, ensuring correct labeling for safety and future maintenance.

Wire Outgoing Circuits Connect the outgoing circuits according to the intended electrical load. Verify that wire gauges, insulation, and breaker ratings match the load requirements.

Verify Connections Use a multimeter to check for continuity, correct voltage, and absence of short circuits. Ensure all connections are secure, properly insulated, and labeled.
