- Use lighter lines for architectural or structural elements and heavier lines for electrical components.
- Ensure symbols are consistent and, if non-standard symbols are used, provide a legend or explanation on the drawing.
- Maintain orientation and scale for clarity; the orientation of the symbol does not change its meaning.
- Include circuit continuation notes if the wiring extends to other drawings.
