Incoming Supply: The main power line enters the DB and connects to the main MCB.

Branch Circuits: Each branch MCB is wired to a specific load or group of loads (e.g., lighting, sockets, HVAC, mini-bar) using insulated wires such as PVC or VIR, depending on local standards.

Neutral and Earth Connections: All neutral wires are connected to the neutral bar, and all earth wires to the ground bar, ensuring proper fault protection.

Automation Integration: Wires from the key card holder or room automation controller are connected to the contactor or relay to control power to designated circuits.

Types of Wiring Used

PVC Insulated Wires: Common for indoor circuits, flexible and fire-resistant.

TRS or CTS Wires: Used for batten or casing-and-capping wiring methods, suitable for temporary or retrofit installations.
