

Cuban-made fiber optic cable factory for smart buildings

Unlike countries such as Morocco, which have fully domestic fiber optic production facilities capable of supplying smart building projects, Cuba currently lacks such industrial capacity. Implications for Smart Buildings Smart buildings require high-quality fiber optic cabling for reliable data transmission, IoT integration, and networked automation. In Cuba, these installations would depend on imported fiber optic cables and international technical support. While the Arimao cable improves backbone connectivity, the absence of local manufacturing means that scaling smart building networks may face supply and cost limitations. Future Prospects Cuba's telecommunications authorities have expressed intentions to expand fiber networks and improve broadband access by 2030 . Achie...
