- MCB Outputs:** Each MCB supplies a specific load, such as lighting, power sockets, or appliances. Single-pole MCBs are typically used for standard loads, while double-pole MCBs may be used for special or high-power loads.
- Neutral and Earth Links:** Neutral wires from each load connect to the neutral bar, and all earth wires connect to the earth bar to ensure proper grounding.
