- High-Precision Leakage Detectors:** Advanced systems integrate current transformers and high-gain linear converters to detect leakage currents as low as 1 mA. These can transmit data to cloud servers for real-time monitoring and alerts.

Protective Devices Leakage Current Protection Switches (ELCBs or RCCBs) are installed in distribution boxes to automatically cut off power when leakage is detected, protecting both people and property. Key considerations when selecting these switches include:
