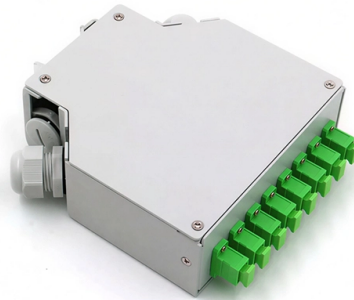

- Remove Cover Carefully:** Loosen bolts or screws securing the cover using certified tools. Avoid prying or forcing the cover, as this can damage the sealing surfaces and compromise the explosion-proof rating.
- Document Wiring and Components:** Take photos or notes of the internal wiring, terminal connections, and component layout. Ensure all wires are labeled to facilitate correct reassembly.
- Disconnect Internal Components:** Carefully disconnect power cables from terminal blocks, ensuring neutral, live, and earth wires are correctly identified.
- Remove internal devices (switches, relays, meters) only if necessary, handling them gently to avoid damage.**
- Inspect Seals and Gaskets:** Explosion-proof boxes rely on tight seals to prevent sparks from escaping. Inspect gaskets and replace if damaged.
