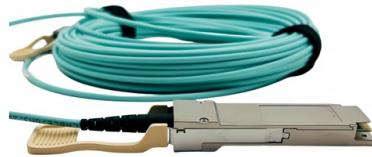


Distance between the electrical distribution box and the fire hydrant



Overview

NFPA 14 - 19' Edition states in 6. 4 the the maximum distance is 100' between the FDC and the nearest fire hydrant unless allowed by the AHJ to be further. The difficulty with determining the spacing of fire hydrants is that every situation is unique and has unique challenges. When hydrants are properly spaced, clearly visible, and easy to access, firefighters can respond faster and operate more effectively during emergencies. This blog explains key fire hydrant placement. "The sides of the transformer must be clear of all objects (including landscaping) for 3ft, and the transformer should be located 10ft horizontally from doors, windows or fire hydrants. Every portion of every building on the site must be within a specified distance of a fire hydrant, measured along an approved fire apparatus access route (not as the crow flies).
