

Distance of ladder-type cable trays

The minimum recommended horizontal distance between parallel ladder-type cable trays is 0.6 meters, with vertical spacing of at least 150 millimeters.

Horizontal Spacing When installing two ladder-type cable trays in parallel at the same height, the minimum distance should be 0.6 meters. This spacing ensures sufficient room for maintenance, inspection, and airflow, which is critical for heat dissipation and preventing cables from touching, reducing the risk of short circuits or interference. For power and signal cable trays, a minimum separation of 0.5 meters is recommended to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI), though this can be reduced to 0.3 meters if the trays are shielded.

Vertical Spacing For floor-mounted or stacked trays, the minimum vertical clearance between trays should be 150 millimeters. This allows for proper ventilation, heat dissipation, and future cable installation while maintaining structural integrity. Adequate vertical spacing also prevents cable interference and ensures each tray has room for expansion or rearrangement.

Support Intervals Ladder-type cable trays should be supported at regular intervals to prevent sagging and maintain system integrity. Typical support spans range from 1.5 meters to 3 meters for horizontal runs, depending on tray width, rung spacing, and cable load. Wider trays or heavier cable loads may require shorter support spans to maintain strength and prevent excessive deflection.

Rung Spacing For ladder trays, rung spacing typically ranges from 6 to 18 inches (150 to 450 mm). Smaller rung spacing (6–12 inches) is recommended for small-diameter control and instrumentation cables to prevent drooping and maintain neat installation. Wider rung spacing may reduce tray strength, so load capacity should be verified with manufacturer specifications.
