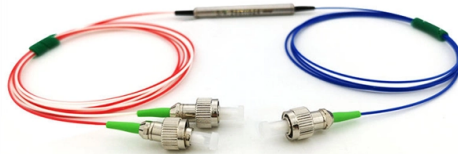

Wire sizes vary by region, for example, 10 AWG in the US and 6 mm² elsewhere, to maintain low resistance and ensure safety.
