A distribution box must be configured and laid out to ensure safety, accessibility, proper load distribution, and compliance with electrical standards. Placement and Environmental Requirements Distribution boxes should be installed close to the load center to minimize cable lengths and power losses, especially in areas with high appliance density or power consumption ().
