The safe and standard method is to draw separate wires from the main switch to each branch circuit, ensuring that each wire carries only the current of its respective circuit. This prevents overload and allows the branch circuit breakers to protect the wires effectively (SMICOPower) . Instead of using jumpers—where one wire feeds multiple breakers—use single bolt parallel groove connectors with heat shrink sleeves or terminal blocks to distribute power safely. This method maintains proper current distribution and avoids overheating (SMICOPower) . Cable Sizing and Arrangement When connecting multiple cables in parallel for high-power applications, it is crucial to: Select the correct cable cross-section based on the current load. Ensure balanced current distribution across all parallel cables to prevent overheating and insulation damage. Follow proper phase sequence and cable arrangement to minimize magnetic interference and impedance differences (Prysmian) . For example, in single-core cable systems, cables should be arranged in a single row sequence to ensure equal current flow and prevent imbalanced heating (Prysmian) . Practical Steps for Wiring Identify input and output terminals of the main MCB, RCCB, and branch MCBs. Connect phase wires from the main switch to the input of each branch MCB individually. Use a neutral link to distribute neutral to all output loads. Connect earth wires to the earth link, ensuring proper grounding. Avoid jumper connections that combine multiple branch circuits on a single wire, as this is prohibited by national standards and can cause overcurrent...
