An Optical Distribution Network (ODN) is the passive fiber infrastructure connecting the OLT to ONUs/ONTs, while optical modules are active components that enable signal transmission and reception in PON systems. Optical Distribution Network (ODN) The ODN is a fully passive layer in a PON that transmits optical signals from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office to multiple Optical Network Units (ONU) or Optical Network Terminals (ONT) at the subscriber side. It is composed of:

- Fiber optic cables: Feeder, distribution, and drop cables that carry light signals over long distances with minimal loss.
- Optical splitters: Passive devices that divide a single optical signal into multiple outputs, supporting ratios like 1:8, 1:16, 1:32, or 1:64, enabling point-to-multipoint topology.
- Connectors and closures: Ensure secure connections and protect splices from environmental damage, maintaining signal integrity.
- Distribution frames and patch panels: Organize, splice, and cross-connect fibers for scalable and maintainable network deployment.

ODNs are designed to optimize signal distribution, minimize optical loss, and reduce operational costs. They are divided into functional layers: Feeder → Distribution → Drop → Premises, which helps manage routing, split ratios, and maintenance. Typical ODN reach is up to 20 km for GPON and 25–30 km for XGS-PON, depending on fiber type and optical budget.

Optical Modules Optical modules are active components installed in OLTs and ONUs/ONTs that convert electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa. Key types include:

- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules: Hot-swappable transceivers used in OLTs for upstream and downstream communication.
- PON cards or EPON link modules: Installed in OLTs to manage multiple PON ports, control bandwidth allocation, and coordinate data transmission to ONUs/ONTs.
- WDM modules: Enable wavelength division multiplexing to separate upstream and downstream signals, increasing network capacity.
