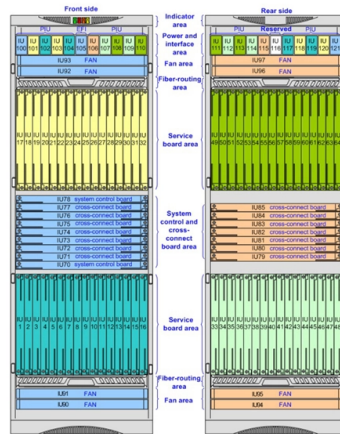


Does PoE require a switch

When a network switch supports PoE or PoE+, it can deliver both power and data directly to connected devices through a single Ethernet cable. In this setup, no additional equipment is needed.
