Standards and Risk Assessment Lightning protection levels (LPL) are defined under IEC 62305 and related standards, which classify protection into Levels I through IV based on the probability and potential severity of lightning strikes. Level 3 protection is commonly applied in approximately 80% of applications, particularly where sensitive equipment is present or where external lightning protection exists. The decision to implement Level 3 protection should follow a risk assessment considering factors such as building location, equipment sensitivity, and potential economic loss from lightning-induced...
