- Enable maintenance safely, as turning off the DP switch ensures no current flows through the connected circuits.

Wiring and Operation A DP switch typically has four terminals: two for incoming power (input) and two for outgoing circuits (output). The switch is mechanically linked so that both poles operate together. When the switch is turned off, both live wires are disconnected simultaneously.

Key wiring considerations include:

- Connecting the incoming live wires to the input terminals.
- Connecting the load wires to the output terminals.
- Ensuring proper grounding for safety.
- Using appropriately rated wires to handle the current load.

Some DP switches are Double Pole Double Throw (DPDT), which can control two circuits and toggle between two outputs, offering more flexibility in complex setups.

Safety and Maintenance Always turn off the main power before wiring or servicing a DP switch. Verify connections with a multimeter to ensure correct operation. Avoid overloading the switch, as excessive current can cause overheating or failure. Regular inspection and testing help maintain safety and longevity.
