Code violations: The National Electrical Code (NEC) requires that each conductor terminate on its own terminal unless the device is explicitly rated for multiple conductors (NEC 110.14(A) and 408.41). Reduced protection: Double wiring can prevent breakers from properly detecting overloads or faults, reducing the effectiveness of the distribution system. Proper Practices Use breakers rated for two wires: Some breakers allow two conductors per terminal; always check manufacturer specifications. Separate lugs for neutrals and grounds: Each neutral or ground wire should terminate on its own terminal unless the bar is designed for multiple wires. Add additional lugs if needed: If a panel has insufficient terminals, properly rated add-on lugs can be installed by a licensed electrician. Follow standard wiring layout: Connect the main supply to the main breaker, then distribute power to branch breakers, with neutrals and grounds properly terminated on their respective bars. Corrective Measures If double wiring is detected: Turn off power at the main isolator. Separate the wires and connect each to its own terminal or use a rated double-wire breaker. Insp...
