- Cable Management:** Use proper cable entry points, secure wiring, and maintain neat routing to prevent mechanical stress and accidental contact.
- Internal Protective Devices** Equip each circuit with fuses, circuit breakers, surge protectors, and relays to safeguard against:
 - Short circuits (phase-to-phase or phase-to-ground)
 - Overloads (sustained excess current)
 - Overvoltages (transient or continuous voltage spikes)Ensure reliability, speed, selectivity, and sensitivity in the protection system so that only the faulty section is disconnected while the rest of the network remains operational.
