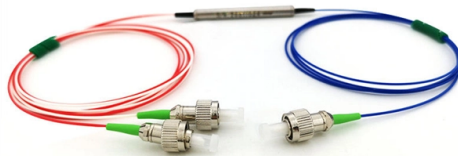

Support spacing must follow NEC guidelines: for EMT, supports are required within 3 meters (10 feet) and within 900 mm (3 feet) of each box or fitting. Minimum burial depth for nonmetallic raceways like PVC is 18 inches below finished grade for circuits up to 600 volts.
3. Environmental Protection Conduits must resist UV radiation, temperature extremes, moisture, and mechanical impact. Outdoor junction boxes must be weatherproof, with sealed gaskets to protect wire connections from rain, snow, and dirt. Consider local environmental factors such as coastal salt air, industrial pollutants, or animal interference, which can degrade conduit over time.
