

Fabrication of Arbitrary Degree Cable Tray Bends

Solid-Bottom or Perforated Trays: Segmental cuts and gradual bending with a press brake or manual bender allow for smooth directional changes. Reinforcement strips or welding maintain structural strength.

Always measure and mark accurately to avoid misalignment. Divide bends into multiple small segments for smoother curves. Use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when cutting or welding. For on-site adjustments, wire mesh trays are easier to bend live, while solid...
