Introduce fiber optic cables through the designated cable inlet using grommets to secure and protect the cables (). Ensure pre-terminated branch fiber jumpers or pigtails are used if applicable. Maintain sufficient slack so that the front panel can be pulled out without stressing the fibers; typically, a minimum of 31 inches of cable length is recommended inside the box ().
- 3. Fiber Routing and Management**
Use bending radius control clips and spools to prevent sharp bends and protect fibers from damage (). Secure fibers with cable ties or movable fasteners to maintain organization and prevent tension (). Avoid coiling fibers around hubs; instead, use splice trays or patch panels for proper routing ().
- 4. Fiber Termination and Splicing**
Strip cable jackets carefully and clean fiber ends with lint-free wipes and alcohol (). Terminate fibers using appropriate connectors (SC, LC, ST) or splice fibers as needed (). Use splice trays or patch panels to organize and protect connections ().
- 5. Grounding, Testing, and Sealing**
For outdoor cabinets, ensure proper grounding to protect against electri...
