Only 5% of men and 9% of women meet the recommended daily fiber intake, highlighting a widespread deficiency. Fiber intake varies by age, gender, and ethnicity: Blacks average 13 grams, Whites 16 grams, and Hispanics 17 grams per day. Fiber density (grams per 1,000 kcal) is higher in adult females and older adults, reflecting differences in food choices and energy intake. Top dietary sources include vegetables, fruits, breads, rolls, tortillas, legumes, nuts, and seeds. Health benefits of adequate fiber intake include improved gastrointestinal function, weight management, reduced risk of cardiovascular disease and type 2 diabetes, lower cholesterol, better blood sugar control, and potential protection against dementia.

Fiber Industry Statistics The global fiber industry was valued at \$550 billion in 2022, with technical fibers projected to grow at a 6.8% CAGR through 2027. Natural fibers still account for 27 million tons, while synthetic fibers, including polyester, dominate with 59 million tons and continue to grow at 4.2% annually. Key sectors driving fiber demand include healthcare nonwovens, packaging, and filtration, with increasing emphasis on recycled materials and sustainable production. Despite growth, only 12% of fiber waste is currently recycled, highlighting sustainability challenges in the industry.
