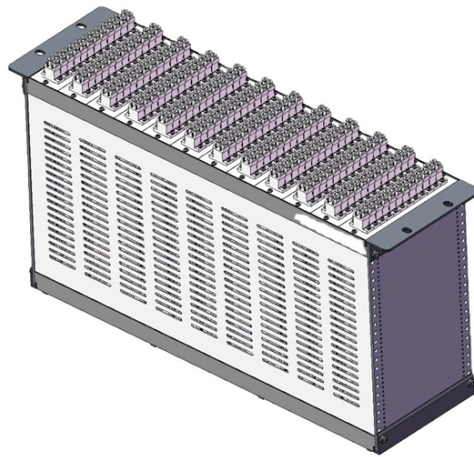


Fiber Optic Cable Color

Outer Jacket Colors
The outer jacket color of a fiber optic cable indicates the type of fiber inside, following the TIA-598-C standard. Common examples include:

Inner Fiber Color Coding
Individual fibers within a cable are color-coded to simplify identification, especially in multi-fiber cables. The 12-color sequence commonly used is: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate (Gray), White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose (Pink), Aqua. For cables with more than 12 fibers, the sequence repeats with stripes or other markings to maintain unique identification for each fiber.

Connector Color Coding
Fiber connectors also use color coding to indicate polish type and compatibility:

- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): Blue connector, flat polish, minimal reflection
- APC (Angled Physical Contact): Green connector, 8-degree angled polish, reduces back reflection
- Multimode connectors: Beige (OM1/OM2), Aqua (OM3/OM4), Magenta (OM4/OM5 in some cases)

It is crucial never to mix UPC and APC connectors, as mismatched angles can permanently damage the fiber core.
